**IMMEDIATELY:** Echo Glen highly encourages training and skill development in a variety of equestrian areas however All TRAINERS shall have a minimum of \$1,000,000 per incident and \$2,000,000 per year in personal liability before providing their services at Echo Glen Farms.

Instructors or other professionals that are brought into the facility to work with a specific boarder only, and are not providing instruction to multiple boarders/tenants at one time nor to non-tenants, shall not be required to be meet the Requirements for Giving Instruction. Boarders recognize that they are scheduling these visits at their own risk, and that these persons must sign our waivers prior to any contact being made

hereinafter referred to as "Owner."

**1. FEES, TERM, AND LOCATION.** Owner acknowledges and accepts those terms set forth in the rate schedule applicable on the date above as issued by Stable, whether said rates be daily, weekly, or monthly. Payment shall be issued in accordance with that rate schedule on a timely basis. Any charges not paid in a timely manner shall be subject to finance charges set forth in the rate schedule. In the event the subject animal is removed from the premises for any reason and returned, this agreement shall be deemed reinstated at rates applicable at the time of said return. Stable reserves the right to notify Owner within fifteen (15) days of the horse's arrival if the horse, in Stable's opinion, is deemed to be dangerous or undesirable for Stable's establishment. In such case, Owner shall be solely responsible for removing the horse within seven (7) days of said notice and for all fees incurred during the horse's presence upon the premises. This Contract shall be deemed terminated and concluded upon the payment of all fees.

The boarding fee is due upon the first of the preceding month. In the event said payment is overdue by ten (10) days, Stable shall be entitled to exert a lien against said horse, and the property upon the premises as more further described below, for any amounts due, and shall be entitled to enforce said lien and foreclose its interest against said horse and/or equipment for the amount due in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon.

Damage Deposit = \$100.00 per stall. This is refundable if all damage is repaired prior to leaving the facility and all areas are left clean. Damage deposits are forfeited in the entirety for any problems as determined for the time being by the Owner.

Use Fee = \$100.00 per stall (non-refundable) will be collected for capital improvements and maintenance of the facility, and is collected annually.

The initial monthly /weekly/ daily (circle one) charge applicable to the services as set forth below shall be \_\_\_\_\_ per day / week / month (circle one).

**2. DESCRIPTION OF HORSE(S) TO BE BOARDED.** Owner agrees to submit a fully completed Owner Information Sheet for each horse boarded upon execution of this agreement. The terms and conditions set forth herein shall be applicable to each and every animal boarded by Owner.

**3. FEED, FACILITIES, AND SERVICES.** Stable agrees to provide adequate feed and facilities for normal and reasonable care required to maintain the health and well being of the animals. Owner acknowledges Owner has inspected the facilities and finds same in safe and proper order. The standard services to be provided herein and the charges therefore are as posted in the office of Stable and are subject to change at Stable's discretion.

**4. RISK OF LOSS AND STANDARD OF CARE.** DURING THE TIME THAT THE HORSE (S) IS/ARE IN CUSTODY OF STABLE, STABLE SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY SICKNESS, DISEASE, ESTRAY, THEFT, DEATH OR INJURY WHICH MAY BE SUFFERED BY THE HORSE (S) OR ANY OTHER

CAUSE OF ACTION, WHATSOEVER, ARISING OUT OF OR BEING CONNECTED IN ANY WAY WITH THE BOARDING OF SAID HORSE (S), EXCEPT IN THE EVENT OF NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF STABLE, ITS AGENTS, AND/OR EMPLOYEES. THIS INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ANY PERSONAL INJURY OR DISABILITY THE HORSE OWNER, OR OWNER'S GUEST, MAY RECEIVE ON STABLE'S PREMISES.

The Owner fully understands that Stable does not carry any insurance on any horse(s) not owned by it for boarding or for any other purposes, whether public liability, accidental injury, theft or equine mortality insurance, and that all risks connected with boarding or for any other reason for which the horse(s) in the possession of, and on the premises of Stable are to be borne by the Owner. Stable strongly recommends equine mortality insurance be obtained applicable to the subject horse(s) by Owner.

THE STANDARD OF CARE APPLICABLE TO STABLE IS THAT OF ORDINARY CARE OF A PRUDENT HORSE OWNER AND NOT AS A COMPENSATED BAILEE. IN NO EVENT SHALL STABLE BE HELD LIABLE TO OWNER FOR EQUINE DEATH OR INJURY IN AN AMOUNT IN EXCESS OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) PER ANIMAL. OWNER AGREES TO OBTAIN EQUINE INSURANCE FOR ANY ANIMALS VALUED IN EXCESS OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000), AT OWNER'S EXPENSE, OR FOREGO ANY CLAIM FOR AMOUNTS IN EXCESS OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000). OWNER AGREES TO DISCLOSE THIS ENTIRE AGREEMENT TO OWNER'S INSURANCE COMPANY AND PROVIDE STABLE WITH THE COMPANY'S NAME, ADDRESS AND POLICY NUMBER. FAILURE TO DISCLOSE INSURANCE INFORMATION SHALL BE AT OWNER'S RISK.

**5. HOLD HARMLESS.** Owner agrees to hold Stable harmless from any and all claims arising from damage or injury caused by owner's horse(s) to anyone, and defend Stable from any such claims. Owner agrees to disclose any and all hazardous or dangerous propensities of horse(s) boarded with Stable.

**6. EMERGENCY CARE.** Stable agrees to attempt to contact Owner should Stable feel that medical treatment is needed for said horse(s), but, if Stable is unable to contact Owner, Stable is then authorized to secure emergency veterinary, and blacksmith care required for the health and well-being of said horse(s). All costs of such care incurred shall be paid by Owner within fifteen (15) days from the date Owner receives notice thereof, or Stable is authorized, as Owner's agent, to arrange direct billing to Owner.

STABLE SHALL ASSUME THAT OWNER DESIRES SURGICAL CARE IF RECOMMENDED BY A VETERINARIAN IN THE EVENT OF COLIC, OR OTHER LIFE-THREATENING ILLNESS, UNLESS STABLE IS INSTRUCTED HEREIN OR ON OWNER'S INFORMATION SHEETS, BY OWNER THAT THE HORSE (S) IS/ARE NOT SURGICAL CANDIDATES.

Owner agrees to notify Stable of any and all change of addresses, emergency telephone numbers, itineraries or other information reasonably necessary to contact Owner in the event of an emergency. In the event Owner departs for vacation or is otherwise unavailable, prior to departure Owner shall notify Stable as to what party is authorized to make decisions in the Owner's place with regard to the health, well-being, and/or medical treatment of the horse(s).

**7. LIMITATION OF ACTIONS.** Any action or claim brought by Owner against Stable for breach of this Contract or for loss due to negligence must be brought within one (1) year of the date such claim or loss occurs.

**8. SHOEING AND WORMING.** Owner agrees to provide the necessary shoeing and worming of the horse(s) as is reasonably necessary, at Owner's expense. Owner agrees to provide Stable with all health records with regard to the horse(s). Owner agrees to have the horse(s) wormed and vaccinated on a regular schedule, and in the event same is not accomplished and proof of same presented to Stable within thirty (30) days from the date of such services or veterinary treatment, Stable is authorized to arrange for such treatment, but not obligated to do so; such expense shall be the obligation of Owner, and upon presentation by Stable of the bill for such services rendered, including service charges, any bill shall be paid within fifteen (15) days from the date the bill is submitted to the Owner.

**9. OWNERSHIP-COGGINS TEST.** Owner warrants that he owns the horse(s) and will provide proof satisfactory to Stable of the negative Coggins test upon request. All shots and worming shall be up to date when the horse arrives. A second sheet will be available to list when said shots or worming occurred last.

**10. CHANGES OR TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT.** It is agreed by the parties that this Agreement may be changed or terminated upon thirty (30) days notice, regardless of the rental period. All notices must be issued in writing unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties. The posting of updated rate schedules in a conspicuous or open place in Stable's office shall constitute notice of any and all rate changes or regulation changes as may be deemed appropriate by Stable.

**11. RULES AND REGULATIONS.** The Owner agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Stable. In the event someone other than the Owner shall call for the horse(s), such person shall have written authority signed by the Owner to obtain said horse(s).

**12. RIGHT OF LIEN.** The Owner is put on notice that Stable has a right of lien as set forth in the laws of this state, for the amount due for the board and keep of such horse(s), and also for storage and services, and shall have the right, without process of law, to retain said horse(s) until the amount of said indebtedness is discharged. However, Stable will not be obligated to retain and/or maintain the horse(s) in question in the event the amount of the bill exceeds the anticipated unregistered value of the horse(s). In the event Stable exercises Stable's lien rights as above-described for non-payment, this Agreement shall constitute a Bill of Sale and authorization to process transfer applications from any breed registration as may be applicable to said horse(s) upon affidavit by Stable's representatives setting forth the material facts of the default and foreclosure as well as Stable's compliance with foreclosure procedures as required by law. In the event collection of this account is turned over to an attorney, Owner agrees to pay all attorney's fees, costs, and other related expenses for which a minimum charge of \$250.00 will be assessed.

**13. PROPERTY IN STORAGE ON STABLE'S PREMISES.** Owner may store certain tack and equipment on the premises of Stable at no additional charge to Owner. However, Stable shall not be responsible for the theft, loss, damage or disappearance of any tack or equipment or other property stored at Stable as same is stored at the Owner's risk. Stable shall not be liable for the theft, loss, damage, or disappearance of any tack or equipment taken to horse shows or clinics. Vehicles stored upon the premises will be subject to a \_\_\_\_\_/day storage cost for all delinquent accounts.

**14. INHERENT RISKS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK.** The undersigned acknowledges there are inherent risks associated with equine activities such as described below and hereby expressly assumes all risks associated with participating in such activities. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to the propensity of equines to behave in ways such as, running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; the unpredictability of equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;

certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; collisions with other animals; the limited availability of emergency medical care; and the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within such participant's ability.

**15. ENTIRE AGREEMENT.** This contract represents the entire agreement between the parties. No other agreements, promises, or representations, verbal or implied, are included herein unless specifically stated in this written agreement. This contract is made and entered into in the State of Oregon, and shall be enforced and interpreted in accordance with the laws of said State.

**16. ENFORCEABILITY OF CONTRACT.** In the event one or more parts of this contract are found to be unenforceable or illegal, the other portions hereof shall be deemed in full force and effect.

## RULES AND CONDITIONS

The following rules and conditions are provided to ensure the safety of all tenants and horses, and to help promote the enjoyment of equitation for all tenants and visitors. Failure to follow these rules may be grounds for termination of the tenant's lease. Please remember that you are responsible for the actions of anyone you invite, or allow, to visit the facility.

These conduct guidelines are intended to promote honest and ethical conduct and to deter wrongdoing. All tenants, shall be held to the same standards regarding these rules and conditions. Any known or suspected violation of the rules, including actions or failures to act, must be promptly reported.

Persons that are found to be violating these rules shall be notified and shall be held accountable for adhering to the rules from the time of such notification. Extreme violations may result in disciplinary action, up to and including immediate termination of the lease. All tenants are expected to treat each other and other persons on or around the facility with respect.

## GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Boarding fees will be paid in a timely manner either with the application packet or upon check-in prior to any horse being allowed in the facility.
2. All tenants are required to check into stall(s) and to sign off on the initial condition. Even though Echo Glen may be doing the feeding and cleaning, your stall is your responsibility until you check out. Failure to do so may result in the loss of your damage deposit.
3. All boarders and their authorized guests shall sign the Rider Release and Covenant Not to Sue (Release form), and submitted to be kept on file prior to bringing the horse onto the property or having contact with any horse.

Minors (under the age of 18) must have written Guardian /parental signatures on file Echo Glen's owner prior to any contact with any horse. THIS INCLUDES ANY VISITORS THAT YOU OR YOUR CHILDREN MAY BRING TO THE BARN, WHETHER RIDING OR NOT. If contact with a horse will be made, a waiver must be signed.

Minors(under the age of 18) are also REQUIRED to wear helmets at all times when riding horses on the property.

4. Children 13 and under must be directly supervised by an adult at all times. This includes children who have a release form on file unless when given specific permission by the instructor or owner. Please remember that not all owners are child-aware, and not all horses are friendly. Additionally, no farm animals are to be chased by children at any time.
5. Horse owners may keep only approved horses at the facility. Be prepared to show a brand inspection and/or lease agreement papers as proof of ownership of your horse(s).

6. The tack room is shared by all with each boarder being given one double cubby. There are multiple bridle hooks and saddle racks available. We are working to provide a separate storage room for trunks, extra blankets etc, that will also be shared by all.
7. Any tenant wishing to use a space other than their assigned stall must have prior approval by the owner. This applies to use of any stall for any reason for any period of time, except in the case of an emergency. Emergencies are defined as a situation requiring immediate action to avoid damage or injury to one or more horses, tenants or guests, or the facility. Emergency situations must be reported to one or more people immediately! In no case should a horse that has been moved to another stall be left there without contact of the owner being made.
8. No sub-leasing of stalls will be allowed. When assigning horses to stalls, care and consideration is taken to ensure that they will get along with their neighbors. Moving horses to other stalls can disrupt the horses next to them and cause distress to horses and owners. This includes use of stalls of other horses that are not present with or without the owner's permission. Issues of damage and cleanliness arise from this unauthorized use.
9. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Inappropriate behavior may include, but is not limited to, use of profanity, drunkenness, and hostile or aggressive behavior toward any other tenant, tenant's property, visitor, horse, or barn owner. No alcoholic beverages will be consumed while riding at the facility. No smoking is allowed at the facility.
10. Safe conditions must be maintained. It is the horse owner's responsibility to notify the barn management or leave a note on the board next to the stairs to inform us of dangerous situations: Please inform us when you find sharp, protruding, or hazardous objects shall be allowed at the facility. Once we are finished with our own construction, no construction material may be stored anywhere on the site.
11. Due to the nature of some horses when confronted with an unknown dog, all dogs must be restrained at all times while on the Facility grounds. Dogs shall not be left unattended while tied up. Owners who bring their dogs to the facility are required to clean up any messes made by or caused by their dog. If any problems occur with the dogs, the barn owner shall have the authority to prohibit that dog's entrance to the Facility. Please remember that not all people enjoy dogs and be respectful of others who may be present.
12. Vehicles and trailers shall be parked in designated areas only. Vehicles may be pulled through the aisles between stall spaces only for loading and unloading of equipment, feed, etc. and should be moved immediately once the task is completed. When parking at the ends of the barn, please be aware of any other owners who may wish to make use of the hitching posts.
13. Damages and stalls not cleaned upon permanently leaving the facility will result in a forfeiture of the entire damage deposit for that stall, and additional charges may be made if the deposit does not cover the cost of repairing the damages. Failure to pay these damages will carry over to consideration for stall space in future years. Boarder/Tenant shall not add any permanent items to stalls without the owner's permission.

Additional charges may be made if the deposit does not cover the cost of repairing the damages. Tenant shall not add any permanent items to stalls without permission, and shall not cause any damage (such as holes from screws or bolts) to panels and gates.

14. Echo Glen Farms will not be responsible for theft or damage to personal property left at the facility. This facility is not generally open to the public, and all items that are valuable to you should be locked up in your vehicle or taken with you. Echo Glen Farms does not carry insurance that covers any items you may bring to the facility – please check your homeowner’s or renter’s policy for this.

15. All gates to the arenas are to be left in a closed and latched position to protect the hinges and others as they are walking/driving past

16. No unattended objects should be left in any aisle ways or driving areas. Bicycles and toys are not allowed in the walking path-ways of the horses at any time. Wheelbarrows will be put away after each use.

17. Our facility attracts a variety of wildlife. Elk, coyotes, deer and of course the ever-present birds all visit the horse. And, then the ever present mice are always an issue—which is why we LOVE our barn cats so much! Please be aware of these creatures when you are placing items in and around your stalls, and if you visit the facility during times when these animals may be active. It is recommended that any grain or feed other than hay be kept in the feed room, in rodent proof containers, to keep wildlife and other horses out of it.

#### SPECIFIC HORSE RULES:

18. Horses must be in good health when they enter the facility. They must have had all required vaccinations as provided on the attached list no less than 2 weeks nor more than 6 months prior to their arrival. Generally these vaccinations are for the protection of your horse, as there are other horses that are brought into our facility for short term stays that may have been exposed to diseases not generally found in our area.

19. If a horse develops any communicable disease, it will be placed in isolation. A veterinarian, at the owner’s expense, will monitor the horse. If, in the opinion of the veterinarian, other horses could be infected, every effort will be made to completely quarantine said horse but may require that the horse be removed from the facility—as into veterinary care etc. In the case that a horse is removed from the facility due to a communicable disease, a certificate of clean health will be required before the horse’s return.

20. Feeds for horses on specialty diets will be provided by their owners. Echo Glen will provide two daily feedings of quality grass hay, the variety will depend on the nature and condition of the horse. Additionally a low calorie “chewing” hay may be provided mid-day or during evening feeds when the weather makes it so the horses are unable to be turned out.

Horses will be grained one time daily. One scoop of Purina Strategy Professional Formula (Fat) or Purina Strategy Ultium (low fat) (<http://horse.purinamills.com/products/strategy/ECMD2-0032691.aspx>) will be fed to working horses with their evening feed. Additional feed oats are also available if the owner desires more calories. Ponies may or may not receive grains—depending on body condition -- they may be too fat!



21. While not open to the “General Public” our facility is frequented by many visitors who may be unaware of the nature of horses. Many of these are children, who love to feed the horses. If you do not wish to have your horse fed, or if your horse is a potential danger to these visitors, it is highly recommended that you place some type of notification on the front and back ends of your stall. In addition, providing this information to other tenants will be helpful in protecting your horse and the visitors.

22. Be aware that these people may be around when you take your horse out of its stall, or when you are riding. Polite conversation with these visitors will help ensure that everyone is safe. If persistent problems occur, please be sure to contact the owner for assistance.

23. Stalls will/are to be cleaned every day. There is a covered shed behind the barns for manure. Large buckets and “poop forks” will be situated around the barn area. Please clean up if your horse poops when outside their stall tied up, in the grooming or shower area, indoor/outdoor arena etc.

24. Due to the size of the stalls, the management recommends that each horse be exercised frequently, especially during the winter. If not in use, the OUTDOOR arena is available for horses to be able to run, roll, and generally stretch their legs if you do not have time to actually ride HOWEVER it is requested that you PLEASE CLEAN UP ANY MANURE LEFT BEHIND!!!

25. STALLIONS—there are in-tact colts and stallions on the property. These stallions are often turned out with the general colt and gelding herd separate from mare pastures in a gelding population.

We do not have separate accommodations for stallions.

BREEDING— Stallion breeding behavior is unpredictable, thus, NO BREEDING ACTIVITIES or COLLECTIONS will be conducted on the property when any guests are around.

26. CATTLE – Due to tax reasons we have a small herd of cattle ranging the property. The cows and some of the steers are docile and love treats and to be patted. Please make sure that if you do feed them you feed them appropriate treats: stale bread (taken out of the bag please!!!), sliced carrots and fruit (no peach pits!!!), horse treats etc.

BULL—We have a young bull named Bullseye. THE BULL IS NOT A PET. Bullseye will be in with the cows and calves during the breeding season ~May-August. Please beware that while he has never been aggressive we do not want to make him so. If you come into contact with Bullseye, please give only limited eye contact and **quietly walk the other direction**. If you are feeding treats, during the breeding season, and Bullseye wants some also, toss said treat toward him, at a safe distance from your person, and then walk quietly to put a cow between you.

## SPECIFIC ARENA RULES:

27. Depending on the barn population, jumps and/or obstacles in the arena must be removed from at least ½ of the arena immediately after use and stored in designated areas. No obstacles shall be used in the arena for night riding except under the supervision of a trainer or on specific jump nights. (EG someone needs to be watching.)

28. We highly encourage riding diversity, thus, any tenant wishing to schedule an activity in the indoor, outdoor or Olympic Pitch arenas should submit a written proposal to the owner for approval. Activities scheduled in advance will always take priority in the arena.

29. Unless during prescheduled activities, lessons will use half of the arena to allow for multiple uses.

30. All tenants and other people authorized to use the Facility shall be required to:

- a) Wear hard soled boots with a heel and a helmet while receiving instruction.
- b) Wear a helmet with a chin-strap when jumping. All minors under 18 years of age are required to wear helmets whenever riding.
- c) Be supervised by an adult when jumping, if jumper is a minor.
- d) Any user of the facility must wear hard soled boots while riding in the arena.

**\*\* Any violation of any of the above is at your own risk.\*\***

31. NO LOOSE HORSES ARE ALLOWED IN THE INDOOR ARENA. The outdoor arena may be used for exercise and riding. Round pen usage will be limited to 30 minutes if other tenants are present and wish to use the round pen. The owner highly encourages communication between tenants regarding use of the arenas.

32. No loose horses are permitted while anyone is riding in the outdoor arena. If a horse is turned out in the arena and you wish to ride, you are responsible for contacting the owner of that horse and giving them enough time to remove their horse from the arena, prior to entering with your horse.

### **33. Equine Liability Insurance:**

**BOARDERS:** It is required that every Tenant carry Equine Personal Liability Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000. There are many insurance companies that offer this coverage, and it is also generally available as a rider on a homeowner's insurance policy. Please contact the owner if you are having difficulty obtaining this insurance. We will verify your coverage at the time we receive your application. Please note that the applications will be denied if you do not have this in place.

**TRAINERS:** All trainers that will be giving instruction on a regular basis must carry a \$1,000,000 liability policy. Again, such policies may be found via resources over the internet.

34. The owners of Echo Glen Farms recognize that horses can be expensive, and at times it is advantageous to have help with costs and care. Commercial leasing or renting of horses, other than those owned by Echo Glen, is not allowed from our facility; however sharing a lease with no more than two other persons for the care and use of your personal horse is allowed. Liability insurance for each of these persons is required to be submitted to be kept on file by the owner. In addition, the boarder who signs our lease will ultimately be held responsible for all items under the lease and these rules.

38. Tenants that wish to receive instruction for working with their horse shall be free to do so. If they will be receiving instruction in any type of activity that will require exclusive use of the arena, this must be scheduled in advance. Instructors or other professionals that are brought into the facility to work with a specific boarder only, and are not providing instruction to multiple tenants at one time nor to non-tenants, shall not be required to be meet the Requirements for Giving Instruction. Tenants recognize that they are scheduling these visits at their own risk, and that these persons must sign our waivers prior to any contact being made.
